Each bridge costs \$200 and can be installed quickly in the rainforest to bridge the gap where there is no current tree connection.

Did you know that sloths are the most frequently admitted species to rescue centers in Costa Rica?

Rescue centers in the South Caribbean area of Costa Rica receive 2-3 sloths per day!

If we do not make immediate changes, sloths may be extinct in our lifetime!
